(9)	Community Benefit The Trust has nearly £100k in funds from our investment in Sron Soire windfarm. It has always been the intention of the Trust to keep the money from this investment for bigger projects. Our agreement with Sron Doire windfarm allows the Trust to roll over 3 years of income. Our income has not been huge over the 6 years of dividend the Trust has received but it is now time to revisit how we use this community dividend. Following discussion, the Board agreed the following suggestions: • Join Community Benefit from RES Freasdail and Sron Doire windfarm community dividends together in 1 pot. • Retain £30-35k annually for dispersal to local groups for up to 50% of costs of a project e.g. new equipment, events, maintenance. This amount to be index linked. • Support new development projects with a smaller number of grants of up to £30 -40k, around 1-2 per year. • Support will be in the region of 10-20% of the value of a new development. • All plans, planning permission, rest of funding to be in place before TSCT grant can be released. • TSCT Grant is final piece of the jigsaw, although a letter of intention can be provided to support grant applications. • Larger Community Benefit grants will support projects and work identified in the Tarbert & Skipness Community Plan. The above was broadly accepted with agreement to have an independent eye look over it and draw the policy together, suggestion GLIC associates or Charles Reppke.
