The company made an investment by way of shares and loans, totalling £170,000, in Srondoire Wind Farmers Limited on 18 February 2015. Part of this is an investment in shares of £29,822 and the remainder is a loan. This loan is being repaid and at the balance sheet date amounts to £91,115. Power generation began successfully in November 2015. The wind farm has continued to perform satisfactorily and dividends continued to be distributed to shareholders in the current financial year. The company has no employees.

During the year the company paid a dividend to Tarbert & Skipness Community Trust of £16,000.
